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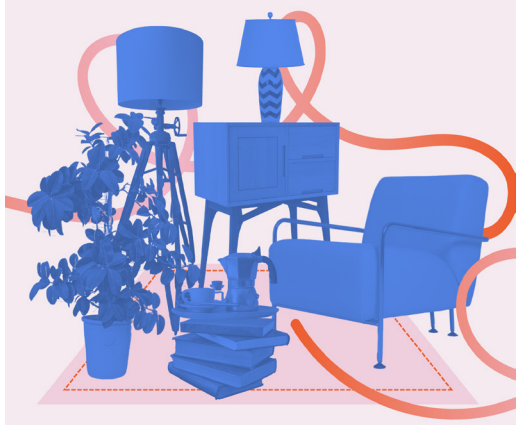

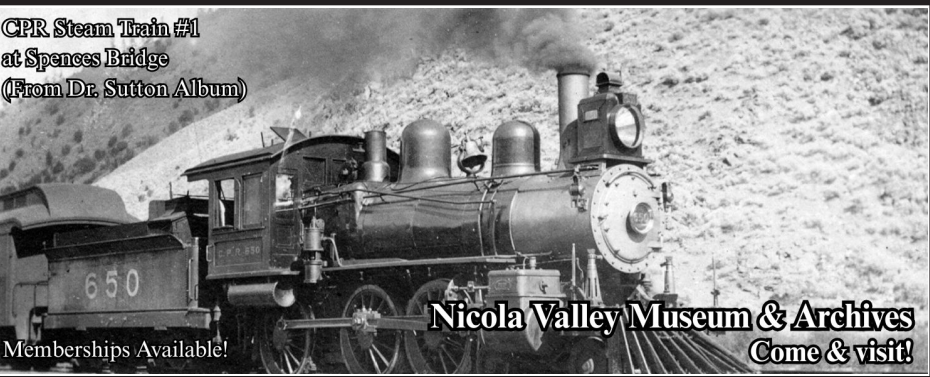

tion instead of authentic transformation." Regional Chief Terry Teegee states, "Under the framework of the Declaration Act (2019) in British Columbia, First Nations have intensified their pursuit of economic, social and cultural development. First Nations' rights to lands, territories and resources that they have traditionally owned or used for millennia are key to cultural survival and environmental sustainability. By embracing and empowering the Declaration Act, First Nations and all British Columbi- ans benefit from efforts to correct historical wrongs and advance reconciliation, as it guides governments and institutions in eliminating discrimination and promoting equality. We must continue to commit to moving forward together to ensure thriving and healthy communities."

United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples

UNDRIP is a human rights instrument — declarations, conventions and treaties to uphold human rights in international law — that sets out the rights of Indigenous peoples around the world. Though not often legally binding, they provide authorita- tive ideas and approaches that can influence state laws and practices.

The Declaration contains 46 articles describing collective and individual rights. States and governments as responsible for protecting and upholding these rights. Its goal is to defend the survival, dignity and well-being of Indigenous people. Existing international human rights instruments already apply to Indigenous peoples, but UNDRIP makes the case that they may need special protections. It defines specific rights related to Indigenous identities, livelihoods and ways of knowing and being in the world.

BC's Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act

The BC government passed the Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act (Declaration Act) into law in November 2019. It establishes the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples as the Province's framework for reconciliation, as called for by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action. It aims to create a path forward that respects the human rights of Indigenous Peoples while introducing better transparency and predictability in the work done together.

There are 4 key areas of the legislation: the govt must bring provincial laws into alignment with the UN Declaration. It must develop and implement an action plan, in consultation and co-operation with Indigenous Peoples, to meet the objectives. It requires regular reporting to the legislature to monitor progress on the alignment of laws and implementation of the action plan. It must allow for flexibility for the Prov to enter into agreements with a broader range of Indigenous governments and to exercise statutory decision-making authority together.
