Mayors present WCCRP at UBCM

At the 2026 UBCM Talk Forum, the mayors of Merritt, Princeton, Hope and Chilliwack gathered to present the West Coast Corridor Resiliency Partnership and share a united message: protecting BC's critical economic corridors requires coordinated investment in the communities that keep them moving.

Along with Abbotsford, these communities form the WCCRP — for a stronger collective voice to more effectively deal with senior governments.

According to the City of Merritt, momentum is growing. Letters of support from elected leaders, Chambers of Commerce and community organizations have been coming in, showing that the corridor, including the Coq is a regional and national priority.

And they have also received a response from the Prime Minister's Office confirming that the WCCRP info was forwarded to the federal minister responsible for infrastructure for further consideration and continued conversations.

This coordinated approach helps governments see how local vulnerabilities are connected. A flood, fire or infrastructure failure in one community can disrupt transportation, supply chains, essential services and economies across Canada. 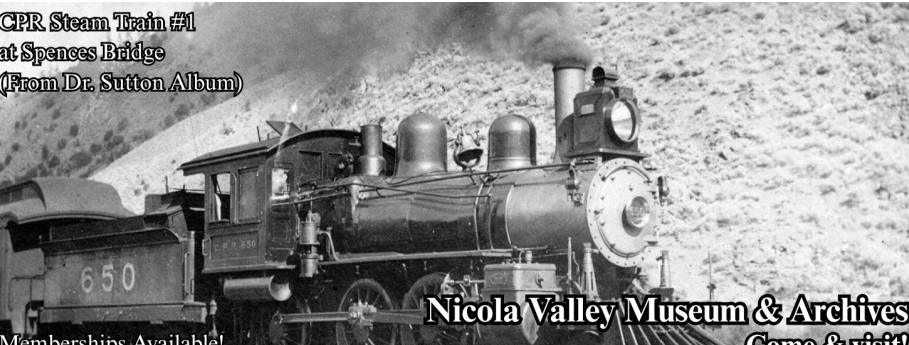
