Starbucks closing

Signs are up on the doors of the Merritt Starbucks on DeWolf Way indicating that they will be closing after today. Today they will be open 6am to 6pm for their last day of business. Starbucks' CEO announced yesterday that they plan to close 250 North American stores 'later this week'. This is the 2nd big round of store closures, with 267 stores closed last September. A letter to employees said that the locations targeted either aren't delivering acceptable financial results or can't provide the kind of experience that Starbucks wants for customers & employees.

If you wish to vote by mail, please visit merritt.ca/elections or Merritt City Hall to obtain an application to receive a mail ballot package. It is your responsibility to ensure that your completed ballot is delivered to the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 pm on General Voting Day, Saturday, October 17, 2026, to be counted.

REGISTRATION AT TIME OF VOTING

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following criteria:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day; and,
- A Canadian citizen; and,
- Resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day; and, or
Registered owner of real property in the City of Merritt for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and,
- Not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors will also be required to produce two pieces of identification (at least one of which with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce:

- Two pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity;
- Proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property; and,
- If there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the majority of the property owners.

The registered owner of real property means, whichever of the following is applicable:

- a. the owner of a registered estate in fee simple of the property, unless another person holds an interest in the property referred to in paragraph (b), (c) or (d);
- b. the holder of the last registered agreement for sale, unless another person holds an interest in the property referred to in paragraph (c) or (d);
- c. the tenant for life under a registered life interest in the property, unless another person holds an interest in the property referred to in paragraph (d);
- d. the holder of a registered lease of the property for a term of at least 99 years.
